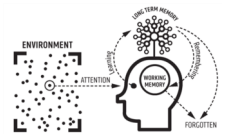

Geography Focus: Towns and Villages

The key vocabulary taught during this half term of Geography sessions will appear in **bold**. Frequent revisiting of this knowledge will aid fluency in Geography.

Geography is the study of places and the relationships between people and their environments. Geographers explore both the physical properties of Earth's surface and the human societies spread across it.



Local area: the places and spaces that are near to us.



town: *Brampton* is our local town. It is near to us.



village: Our school is located in the village of *Lanercost*. *Lanercost* is a village.
